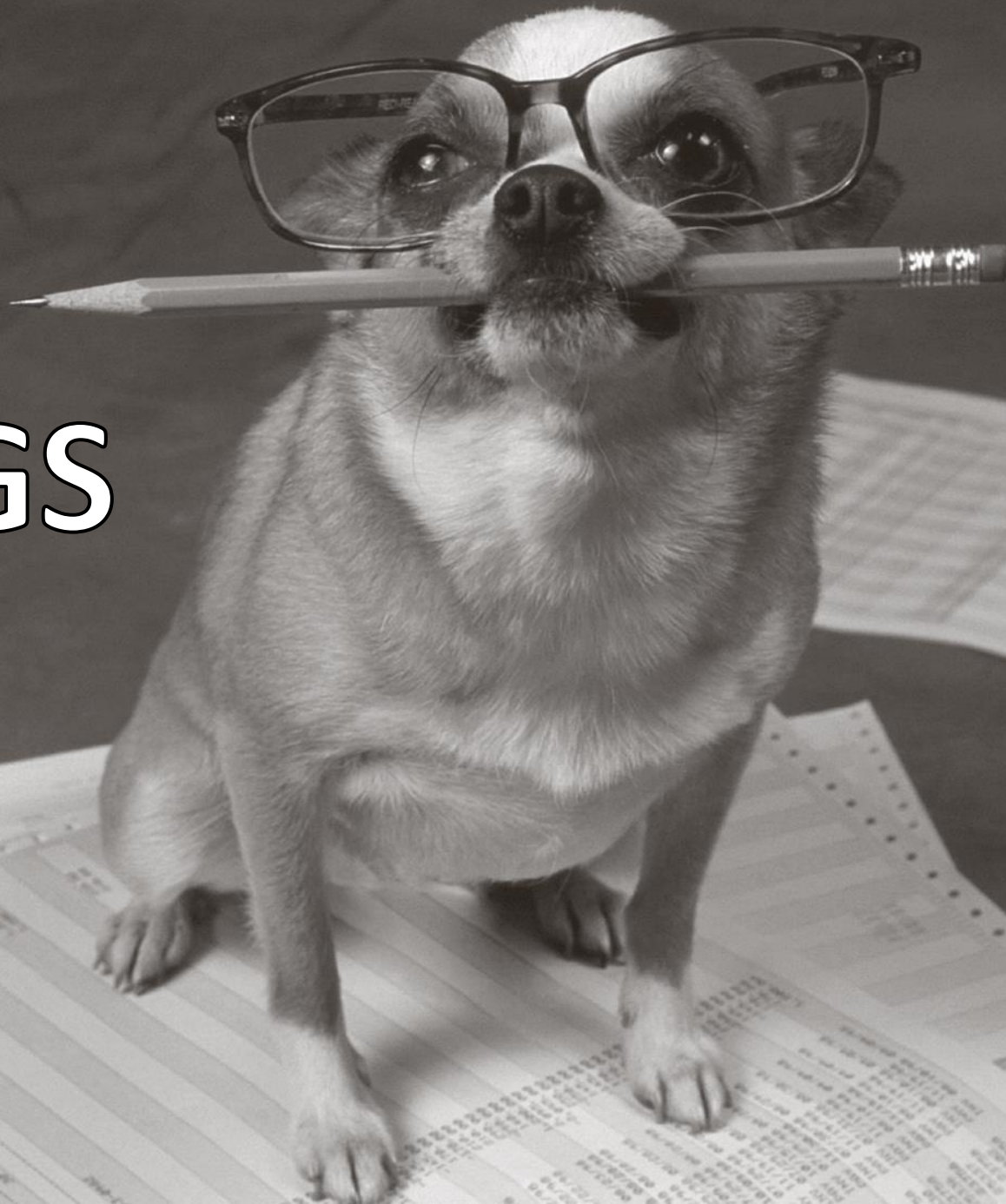

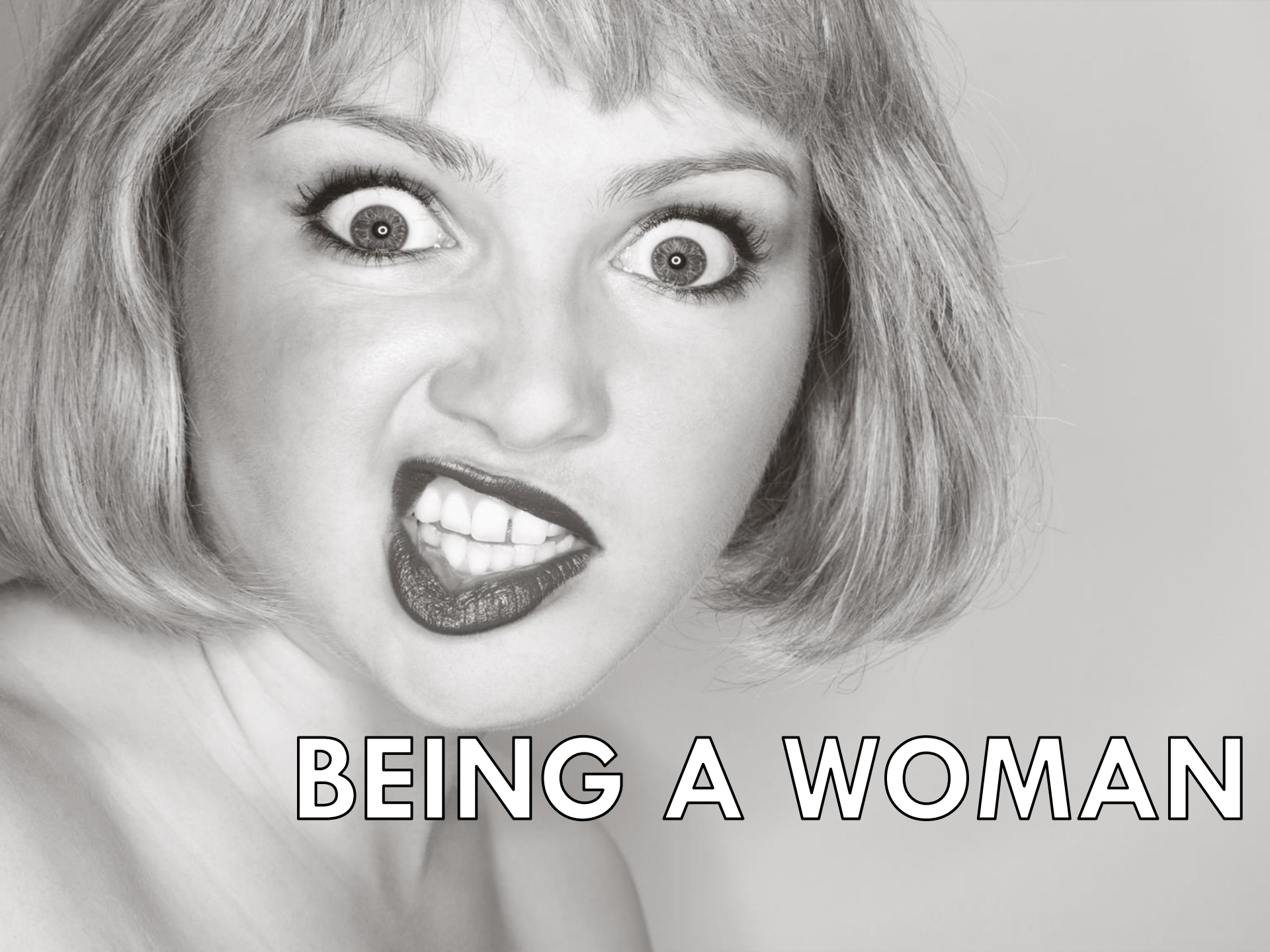

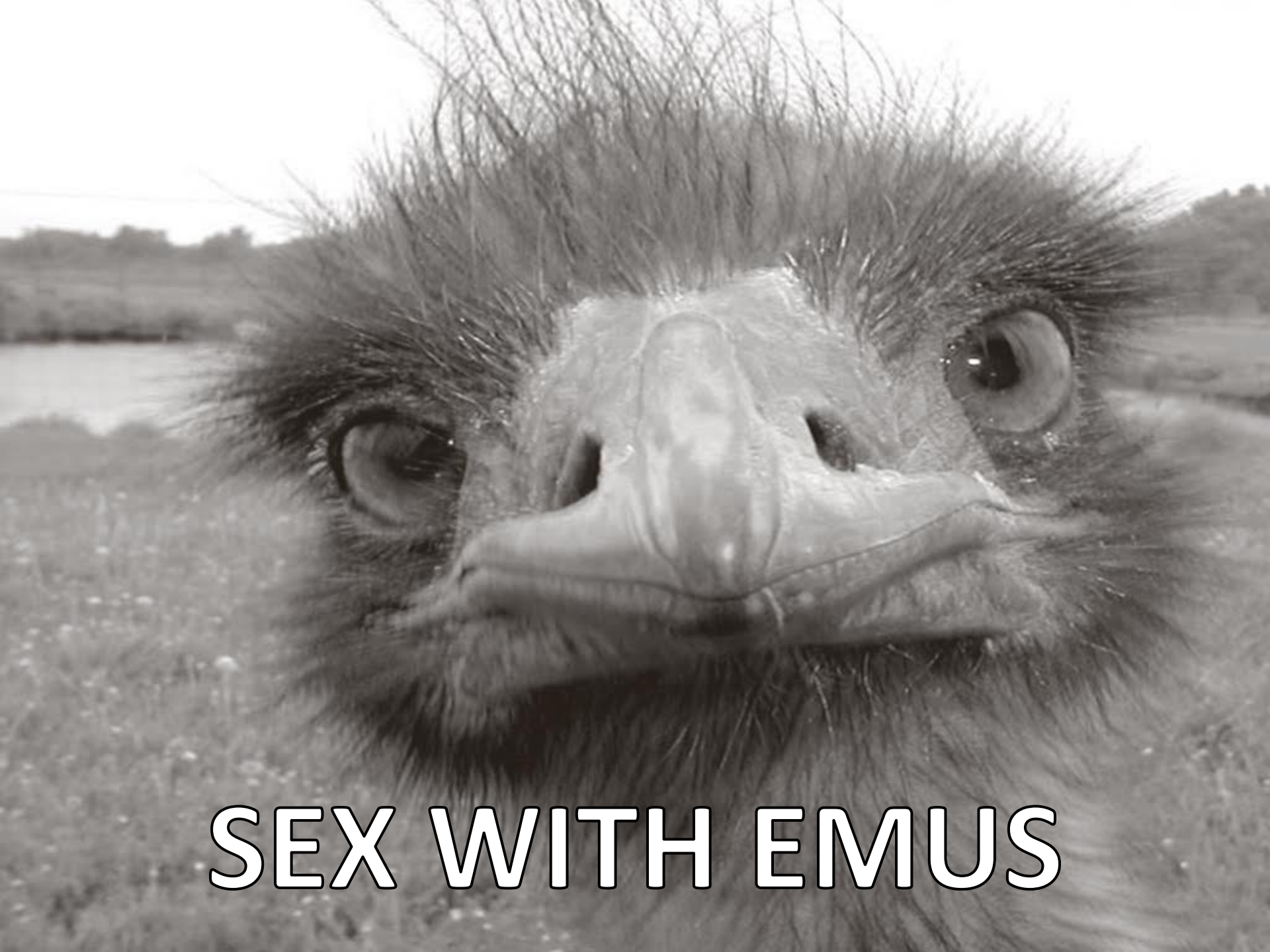

is forced to recruit 300 staff in Hungary...

IS THERE NO ONE LEFT IN BRITAIN WHO CAN MAKE A SANDWICH?

THE UK's biggest sandwich maker wants to recruit hundreds of workers from Eastern Europe because no Britons will do the job. Bosses from GreenCore Group are flying to Hungary today in search of staff for its new factory.

The firm, which supplies Marks

& Spencer, Waitrose, Sainsbury's, Tesco and Asda, admits it will have to recruit most of the 200 workers it needs from overseas.

Its vacancy crisis will re-ignite claims that Britain's generous welfare system has created a generation unwilling to work, while acting as a magnet for foreigners.

Alyson Russell, GreenCore's

human resources director, said the company had tried to recruit in the UK, but that it was 'not always the kind of work' which people wanted to do.

The £35million factory in Northampton, is due to open in early 2015. Mrs Russell said low unemployment meant few locals could be found to fill vacancies, although there are around 6,000 jobless in the town, a rate of 6.8 per cent - the national average, while in
